*Dear Valued Stakeholder,*


*Information outlined in this report is analyzed by both District and building administrators to forecast future enrollment projections and address other important issues that can impact the District moving forward.*

*Percentage of Mequon-Thiensville Resident Children that Make up the Total Population of Lumen Christi & University School*



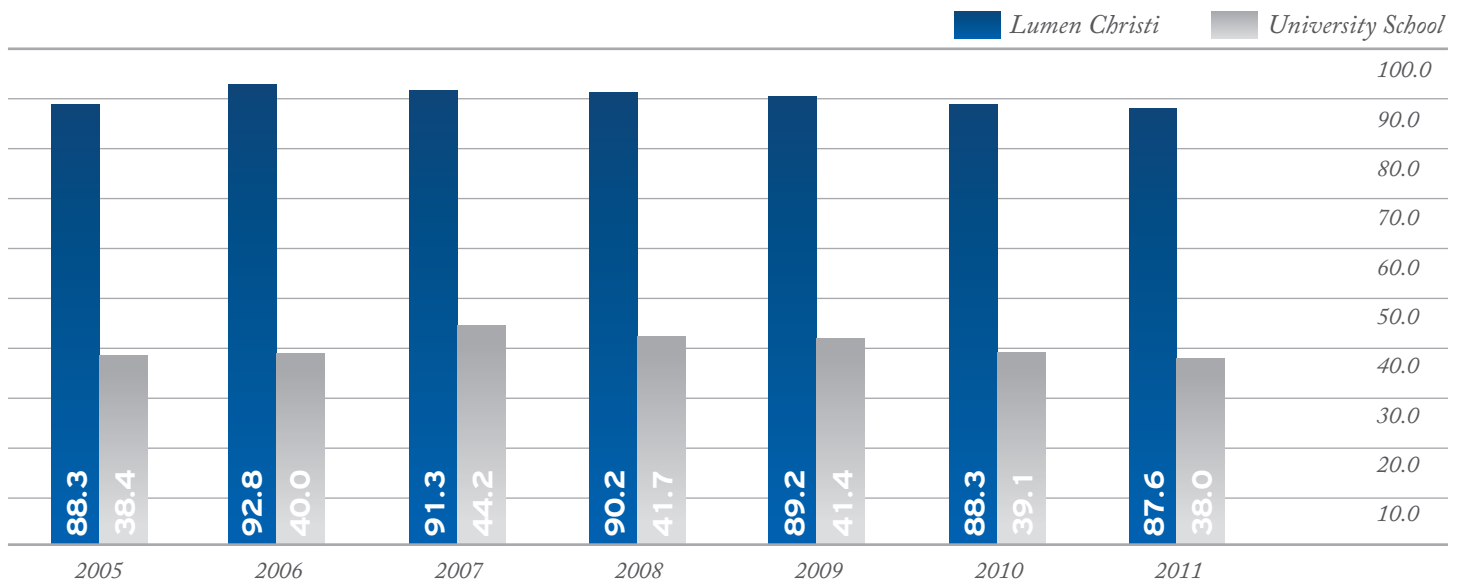
