Developmental Screenings for Mequon-Thiensville Students

The Mequon-Thiensville Preschool Team offers screenings for three and four year old children whose parents or care providers have concerns about a child's speech/language, cognitive, social/emotional, and/or motor skill development. This screening is part of local efforts of Child Find, a component of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) that requires local communities to identify, locate, and evaluate young children with disabilities, who are in need of early intervention or special education services. The screening is service for Mequon-Thiensville School District families and takes place at the Mequon-Thiensville School District Office in the Egelhoff Conference Room two times per year in Fall and Spring.

The screening team includes speech/language pathologists, occupational and physical therapists, as well as preschool psychologists, and special education teachers. Information will also be collected to help the screening around the child's development, preschool experiences, and medical history.

In addition to our developmental screening, we offer monthly speech screenings at our district office as part of child find supports. The speech screening is for any community student where the parent, caregiver and/or school staff has concerns around the child's speech development.
